ACCEPTABLE INTERNET USE AND PERMISSION TO PUBLISH POLICY

Personal Responsibility

By signing this Policy, you are agreeing not only to follow the rules in this Policy, but are agreeing to report any misuse of the network to the administration. Misuse means any violations of this Policy or any other use that is not included in the Policy, but has the effect of harming another or his or her property.

Acceptable Uses

Tabernacle School is providing access to its computer networks and the Internet for educational purposes only.

Unacceptable Uses

1. Uses that violate the law or encourage others to violate the law. For example, don't intrude into the networks or computers of others; or view, transmit, or download material that is confidential, copyrighted, threatening, vulgar, obscene, or protected by trade secrets.
2. Uses that cause harm to others or damage to their property. This includes but is not limited to: harming another's reputation by lies, employing another's password or another user identifier, uploading viruses and other forms of programming or vandalism, and participating in "hacking" activities or any form of unauthorized access to other computers, networks, or information systems.
3. Uses that jeopardize the security of student access and of the computer network. For example, don't disclose or share your password with others; don't impersonate another user.
4. Uses that are commercial transactions. Students may not sell or buy anything over the Internet.
5. Uses of a personal nature, including "My Space and Face Book", checking email, etc., including ipads and phones.

Internet Safety

Although Tabernacle School uses a filter system to prevent students from accessing materials inappropriate for school-aged pupils, and there will always be a teacher present, every user must take responsibility for his or her use of the computer network and Internet. Students are not allowed to "free surf", enter chat rooms, or use any form of "instant messaging". If a student finds that other users are visiting offensive or harmful sites, he or she should report such use to the teacher. To keep the web content as safe as possible, students and staff will be following these guidelines:

- In using the computer network and Internet, the student is not to reveal personal information about themselves or others. Such information includes, but is not limited to addresses, telephone numbers, last names, social security number, credit card numbers, passwords, and any other private or confidential information about themselves or others. Only the first name of a student may be used.
- All web pages posted will be part of a class assignment and/or project.
- Web pages will be reviewed before being posted to prevent unacceptable content.
- Students in photos will not have last names posted.

Privacy

Tabernacle School reserves the right to monitor, inspect, copy, review, and store at any time and without prior notice any and all usage of the computer network and Internet access and any and all information transmitted or received in connection with such usage.

Failure to Follow Policy

The student's use of the computer network and Internet is a privilege, not a right. Any student who violates this Policy, shall at a minimum, have his or her access to the computer network and Internet terminated, which Tabernacle School may refuse to reinstate for the remainder of the student's enrollment at Tabernacle School. Further, a user violates this Policy if he or she permits another to use his or her account or password to access the computer network and Internet, including any user whose access has been denied or terminated. Tabernacle School may also take other disciplinary action in such circumstances.
